THE PONCE DE LEÓN MUSTER

ST. AUGUSTINE, FL – April 3, 2010 – Four hundred and ninety-seven years ago, in April 1513, Don Juan Ponce de León stepped ashore on the east coast of Florida and changed history forever. On April 10, 2010, the first, annual historical muster of the living history group, *La Compañía de Juan Ponce de León* (The Company of Juan Ponce de León), will be held at Ponce de León's Fountain of Youth Archaeological Park (www.fountainofyouthflorida.com/) in St. Augustine, Florida, our nation's oldest city.
